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MEDALLIONS x 4: 2005 "Battle of Trafalgar 200th Anniversary", silver-plated with pictures + capsules + luxury box - top grades (my ref. 185.61)

These 4 medallions were produced for Westminster Collectionst to commemorate the "200th Anniversary of the Battle of Trafalgar". Each medallion has a picture of the battle scene as follows:

1. Vice Admiral Viscount Nelson - commander of the British fleet.
2. HMS Victory - Nelson's flagship captained by Thomas Hardy.
3. Pierre-Charles Villeneuve - commender of the French and Spanish fleet.
4. Bucentaure - Villeneuve's flagship.

All 4 medallions have the same reverse design.

Each medallions has a diameter of 38.5 mm, a weight of 25.8 grams and was struck with silver-plating (I do not think that they are solid silver).

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
